SATURDAY 21 AND SUNDAY 22 APRIL 2018

Afternoon of Saturday 21 April 2018

Members may choose to visit Carlisle Castle and/or Carlisle Cathedral which are walkable from the Gathering venue the Hallmark Hotel or a car can be made available.

[Carlisle Castle](#) – open 10am-6pm, the Queen's Tower where Mary stayed in 1568 and the Queen's Walk are of particular interest. Entrance to the Castle is £10.80 for adults; £6.10 concessions –free for any English Heritage members and people who have been a member of Historic Environment Scotland for more than one year.

[Carlisle Cathedral](#) – open from 7.30am - 6.15pm, Mary would have visited here during her time in Carlisle. Entry is free but donations are very welcome.

6.30pm Evening meal in the Hallmark Hotel

A three course meal in the Hallmark Hotel and a glass of wine or soft drink. Cost is £25 per person.

Sunday 22 April 2018

Following in Mary's footsteps 16-18 May 1568

9.30am Departing from the Hotel and driving by minibus/private cars (depending on the number of people interested) there will be a visit to the place and plaque marking where Mary landed near **Workington** on 16th May 1568. It is about 30 miles west of Carlisle.

10.30am Private visit to the [Helena Thompson Museum](#) in Workington where the 'Luck of Workington' is held – a small agate communion cup that Mary is said to have given to Sir Henry Curwen in gratitude for his kindness on her arrival in England. Entry is free but members are invited to make a donation.

12.30pm We will stop in **Cockermouth** to see the plaque in the main square, commemorating Mary's day there on 17th May 1568.

Lunch will be in the ['Bitter End Pub'](#) on a self-purchase basis and we'll leave at 2.00pm

3pm Evensong Service in Carlisle Cathedral – prayers for Mary will be said as part of this service
